Did you know you can order your repeat medication and also book GP appointments online via patient

access?

All you need is to register with photo ID at reception.



EPS - Electronic Prescription Service

If you sign up for EPS you will not have to visit your GP practice to pick up your paper prescription. Instead, your GP will send it electronically to the pharmacy you choose, saving you time.

You will have more choice about where to get your medicines from because they can be collected from a pharmacy near to where you live, work or shop.

Is this service right for you?

Yes, if you have a stable condition and you:

- -Don't want to go to your GP practice every time to collect your repeat prescription
- -Collect your medicines from the same place most of the time or use a prescription collection service now.

How can you use EPS?

You need to choose a place for your GP practice to electronically send your prescription to or ask any pharmacy to add a nomination for you.

During February we had 101 GP appointments & 87 treatment room appointments that patients did not attend or cancel.

This totals a shocking 188 wasted appointments during February and a cost to the practice of £4406.40

From Monday 1st April 2019:

Please allow <u>72 hours*</u> for your prescription to be processed.



*This is the time taken from dropping off your prescription at the surgery and collecting at the surgery. If you have nominated a pharmacy where you collect from you will need to allow extra time.

When will my prescription be ready?

We require 72 hours (3 working days) to have your prescription ready.

The 'working days' are when the surgery is open (Monday – Friday).
